Literacy, Puppets and STEAM!

Describe your project - include your objectives, materials you will need, and methods you will use.

My project will use puppets and STEAM to enhance our story time and literacy centers. We incorporate stories into our daily lessons to teach skills and objectives. We want to give the students some hands-on tools to help make story time fun and to be able to extend the lesson themselves with story retelling. My objectives for the puppets are to teach skills such as sequencing of stories, concepts and retelling of events. My objectives for the other items in the STEAM kits will help stimulate higher level questions from myself and the students during story time and prompt more conversations about real life situations. The materials we will need are: two STEAM kits, community helper puppets and two puppet theaters. The methods we will use will vary. We will use the puppets for the stories they go with and community helper stories we already have in the classroom that coordinate with the puppets. We will also use the puppets to teach a skill or to help a student with an issue or problem he/she may have. Students have free play in the puppet theater as we are using the puppets to retell or make up their own version of a story. There are many ways to incorporate these puppets and kits into reading and so much more!

How will you determine whether your objectives have been achieved? Provide specific, measurable and time bound results.

I will know my objectives have been met if 90% of my students are able to retell the beginning, middle and end of the story using the puppets by the end of the first semester. I will use observation, conversation, and students' drawings to assess their depth of knowledge of the STEAM activities.

We will use the fairytale puppets and STEAM kits all year beginning in August and ending in May. We will begin community helpers in October. We will use these puppets continually to talk about different careers until the end of the year.
